AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1225, No.316), entitled
2 "An act concerning game and other wild birds and wild
3 animals; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing
4 the law relating thereto," further defining the uniform of an
5 officer.

6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
7 hereby enacts as follows:

8 Section 1. Clause (h) of section 214, act of June 3, 1937
9 (P.L.1225, No.316), known as "The Game Law," is amended to read:

10 Section 214. Powers of Members of Commission, Director, and
11 Game Protectors.--Each member of the commission, the director,
12 and each of its lawfully qualified representatives shall have
13 the power:

14 * * *

15 (h) To stop and inspect or search at any time, without
16 warrant, any vehicle or conveyance, and its occupants or
17 contents, any time or place within this Commonwealth: Provided,
18 however, Such officer shall be in uniform consisting at least of
19 a hat with the insignia or badge of the commission attached

1 thereto and display his badge or other insignia of
2 identification and shall state to the person in charge of said
3 vehicle or conveyance the purpose of the inspection or search;

5 Section 2. Clause (o) of section 731 of the act, amended
6 June 13, 1961 (P.L.306, No.182), is amended to read:

7 Section 731. Penalties.--Any person violating any of the
8 provisions of the sections of this article shall, upon
9 conviction, be sentenced to pay the following fines and costs of
10 prosecution for each offense:

11 * * *

12 (o) For failure or refusing to stop any vehicle or
13 conveyance being operated upon any public highway within this
14 Commonwealth, upon request or signal of any officer in [full]
15 uniform consisting at least of a hat with the insignia or badge
16 of the commission attached thereto whose duty it is to enforce
17 the game law, contrary to the provisions of this article,
18 twenty-five dollars (\$25);
