### AN ACT

1 2 3	Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, redefining an offense relating to persons to whom firearms shall not be delivered.
4	The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
5	hereby enacts as follows:
6	Section 1. Section 6110 of Title 18, act of November 25,
7	1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated
8	Statutes, added December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended
9	to read:
10	§ 6110. Persons to whom delivery shall not be made.
11	No person shall deliver a firearm to any person under the age
12	of [18] <u>21</u> years, or to one he has reasonable cause to believe
13	has been convicted of a crime of violence, or is a drug addict,
14	an habitual drunkard, or of unsound mind, <u>except that a person</u>
15	between the age of 18 and 21 years may receive a shotgun or
16	rifle as those items are defined by the Federal Gun Control Act
17	<u>of 1968 (Public Law 90-618).</u>
18	Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
