## AN ACT

Authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies to acquire, 1 2 on behalf of the Pennsylvania Historical and Museum 3 Commission, a tract of land in the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and making 4 5 appropriations. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 7 hereby enacts as follows: 8 The Department of Property and Supplies is hereby authorized to acquire, on behalf of the Pennsylvania Historical 10 and Museum Commission, the following tract of land with building 11 and improvements thereon erected and known as the Dobbin House, 12 situate in the Borough of Gettysburg, Adams County, founded and 13 described as follows: 14 Tract No. 1 15 Beginning at a front on Steinwehr Avenue; thence along land now or formerly of W. C. Lott, 170 feet 4 inches to a public 16 17 alley 12 feet in width; thence along said alley 82 feet 4 inches

to lands now or formerly of Joseph Redding; thence along said

lands now or formerly of Joseph Redding 160 feet to Steinwehr

- 1 Avenue; thence along said Avenue 53 feet 7 inches to the place
- 2 of beginning.
- 3 Being the same tract of land which Gettysburg Battlefield
- 4 Diorama, Inc., by deed dated April 21, 1967 and recorded in the
- 5 Office of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Adams County,
- 6 Pennsylvania, in Deed Book Vol. 261, Page 653, granted and
- 7 conveyed unto Diorama of Gettysburg, Inc., grantor herein.
- 8 Tract No. 2
- 9 Beginning at a post on sidewalk at lot now or formerly of
- 10 Harry L. Small and Bertha C. Small; thence by same south 84-1/4
- 11 degrees east 55.2 feet to a post at a 12 foot public alley;
- 12 thence by said alley south 36-3/4 degrees west, 96.6 feet to a
- 13 spike; thence north 85-1/4 degrees west 4 feet to a spike at
- 14 sidewalk; thence by said sidewalk north 4-3/4 degrees east, 83
- 15 feet to a post, the place of beginning.
- 16 Being the same property which Gettysburg Battlefield Diorama,
- 17 Inc., by deed dated April 21, 1967, and recorded in the Office
- 18 of the Recorder of Deeds in and for Adams County, Pennsylvania,
- 19 in Deed Book Vol.261, page 653, granted and conveyed unto
- 20 Diorama of Gettysburg, Inc., grantor herein.
- 21 Section 2. The land shall not be acquired until its title
- 22 has been approved by the Department of Justice.
- 23 Section 3. Upon acceptance of the title the Pennsylvania
- 24 Historical and Museum Commission shall be given full control,
- 25 management and supervision thereof, shall restore and preserve
- 26 the historic Dobbin House and its grounds, and shall have the
- 27 power to adopt and carry into effect plans for the improvement
- 28 and maintenance thereof and to make and enforce rules and
- 29 regulations for the preservation of the property and the
- 30 visitation thereof by the public.

- 1 Section 4. (a) The sum of \$125,000 or as much thereof as may
- 2 be necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Department of
- 3 Property and Supplies for the payment of the purchase price and
- 4 incidental expenses, including the completion of an abstract of
- 5 title.
- 6 (b) The sum of \$250,000 or as much thereof as may be
- 7 necessary, is hereby appropriated to the Pennsylvania Historical
- 8 and Museum Commission for the restoration, improvement and
- 9 maintenance of the Dobbin House and its grounds.
- 10 Section 5. This act shall take effect immediately.
