## AN ACT

Amending the act of April 12, 1951 (P.L.90, No.21), entitled "An act relating to alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto; regulating and restricting the manufacture, purchase, sale, possession, consumption, importation, transportation, furnishing, holding in bond, holding in storage, traffic in and use of alcoholic liquors, alcohol and malt and brewed beverages and the persons engaged or employed therein; defining the powers and duties of the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board; providing for the establishment and operation of State liquor stores, for the payment of certain license fees to the respective municipalities and townships, for the abatement of certain nuisances and, in certain cases, for search and seizure without warrant; prescribing penalties and forfeitures; providing for local option, and repealing existing laws," PROVIDING FOR VETERANS' ORGANIZATION LICENSES AND further regulating the transfer OR SURRENDER of a license.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
hereby enacts as follows:
SECTION 1. THE ACT OF APRIL 12, 1951 (P.L.90, NO.21), KNOWN <-
AS THE "LIQUOR CODE," IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ:
SECTION 401.1. VETERANS' ORGANIZATION.--(A) THE BOARD, UPON
RECEIPT OF AN APPLICATION FOR THE TRANSFER OF A LIQUOR LICENSE
board in each case with their recommendations. The board shall, by regulation, fix the license year for each separate district so that the expiration dates shall be uniform in each of the several districts but staggered as to the State.

Section Z 3. Subsection (g) of section 403 of the act, amended November 19, 1959 (P.L.1546, No.553), is amended to read:

Section 403. Applications for Hotel, Restaurant and Club Liquor Licenses.--* * *
(g) Every applicant for a new license, for the transfer of an existing license to another person or for the transfer of an existing license to another premises not then licensed shall post, for a period of at least fifteen days beginning with the day the application is filed with the board, in a conspicuous place on the outside of the premises or at the proposed new location for which the license is applied, a notice of such application, in such form, of such size, and containing such provisions as the board may require by its regulations. Proof of the posting of such notice shall be filed with the board.

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SECTION 4. THE ACT IS AMENDED BY ADDING A SECTION TO READ: <SECTION 475. SURRENDER OF LICENSE BECAUSE OF LOCAL DISASTER OR PHYSICAL CATASTROPHE.--ANY LICENSEE WHOSE LICENSE HAS BEEN SURRENDERED FOR SAFEKEEPING TO THE PENNSYLVANIA LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD BECAUSE OF A LOCAL DISASTER OR A PHYSICAL CATASTROPHE INVOLVING THE PREMISES SHALL BE PERMITTED TO LIFT THAT LICENSE AND RESUME OPERATION OF THE LICENSED BUSINESS AT ANY TIME WITHIN THREE YEARS OF ITS SURRENDER.
