AN ACT

Amending the act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69), entitled "An act concerning townships of the second class; and amending, revising, consolidating, and changing the law relating thereto," authorizing certain fire companies, rescue companies and ambulance companies to purchase petroleum products by way of purchase contracts therefor by the township.

8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania

9 hereby enacts as follows:

10 Section 1. Section 516, act of May 1, 1933 (P.L.103, No.69),

11 known as "The Second Class Township Code," reenacted and amended

12 July 10, 1947 (P.L.1481, No.567), is amended by adding a

13 subsection to read:

14 Section 516. Duties of Supervisors, Township

15 Superintendents, and Roadmasters. -- The township supervisors, or

16 the supervisors employed as superintendents or roadmasters,

17 shall--

18 * * *

1	(n) Permit, subject to such terms and conditions as they
2	may, and as hereinafter specifically provided, shall prescribe,
3	any nonprofit fire company, nonprofit rescue company and
4	nonprofit ambulance company in the township to participate in
5	purchase contracts for petroleum products entered into by the
6	township. Any such company in the township desiring to
7	participate in such purchase contracts shall file with the
8	supervisors a request that it be authorized to participate in
9	contracts for the purchase of petroleum products of the township
10	and agreeing that it will be bound by such terms and conditions
11	as the township may, and as hereinafter specifically provided,
12	shall, prescribe and that it will be responsible for payment
13	directly to the vendor under each petroleum products purchase
14	contract. Among such terms and conditions, the township shall
15	prescribe that all prices shall be F.O.B. destination.
