AN ACT

1 Repealing section 533, act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682, No.284),  
2 entitled "An act relating to insurance; amending, revising,  
3 and consolidating the law providing for the incorporation of  
4 insurance companies, and the regulation, supervision, and  
5 protection of home and foreign insurance companies, Lloyds  
6 associations, reciprocal and inter-insurance exchanges, and  
7 fire insurance rating bureaus, and the regulation and  
8 supervision of insurance carried by such companies,  
9 associations, and exchanges, including insurance carried by  
10 the State Workmen's Insurance Fund; providing penalties; and  
11 repealing existing laws," relating to mutual fire insurance  
12 companies organized before May 1, 1876.

13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
14 hereby enacts as follows:

15 Section 1. Section 533, act of May 17, 1921 (P.L.682,  
16 No.284), known as "The Insurance Company Law of 1921," is  
17 repealed.

18 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
