- 3 <u>Section 5.1. Any police officer previously employed as a</u>
- 4 <u>full-time police officer by one municipality who comes under the</u>
- 5 terms of this act by virtue of an increase in the number of
- 6 <u>full-time police officers employed by his municipality who</u>
- 7 retires or has retired subsequent to January 1, 1970 and upon
- 8 attainment of age sixty-five, without fulfilling the length of
- 9 <u>service requirements under this act, or any full-time police</u>
- 10 officer who, because of his age at the time of his employment is
- 11 prevented from fulfilling the length of service requirements
- 12 <u>under this act, shall receive a proportionate pension based upon</u>
- 13 <u>his years of service.</u>
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
