## AN ACT

- 1 Making it unlawful to have pay toilet facilities under certain 2 circumstances and prescribing penalties.
- 3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 4 hereby enacts as follows:
- 5 Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, PARTNERSHIP, <—
- 6 CORPORATION, TRUST, INCORPORATED ASSOCIATION AND ANY OTHER LEGAL
- 7 ENTITY operting a business, INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO,
- 8 AIRPORTS, TRAIN STATIONS, BUS TERMINALS AND ANY COVERED
- 9 ENTERPRISES AND FACILITIES OPEN TO THE PUBLIC to permit the
- 10 existence in connection therewith of toilet facilities the
- 11 entrance to which or the operation of which requires the payment
- 12 of a consideration.
- 13 Section 2. A violation of this act shall be a summary
- 14 offense punishable by the payment of a fine of \$300 and
- 15 imprisonment for a term of not more than 90 days. Each day of
- 16 violation shall constitute a separate offense.

1 Section 3. This act shall become effective in 30 days.
