20	Section 1. Debt Authorization The Governor, Auditor
21	General and State Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed
22	to borrow, from time to time, in addition to any authorization

- 3 capital budget, money not exceeding in the aggregate the sum of

- 6 four thousand dollars (\$82,694,000) as may be found necessary to
- 7 carry out the acquisition and construction of public improvement
- 8 projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.
- 9 Section 4. Appropriation. -- The net proceeds of the sale of
- 10 the obligations herein authorized are hereby appropriated from
- 11 the Capital Facilities Fund to The General State Authority in
- 12 the maximum amount of [seventy-six million two hundred seventy-
- 13 four thousand dollars (\$76,274,000)] eighty-two million six
- 14 <u>hundred ninety-four thousand dollars (\$82,694,000)</u> to be used by
- 15 it exclusively to defray the financial costs of public
- 16 improvement projects specifically itemized in a capital budget.
- 17 After reserving or paying the expenses of the sale of the
- 18 obligation, the State Treasurer shall pay out to The General
- 19 State Authority the moneys as required and certified by it to be
- 20 legally due and payable.
- 21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
