AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513, No.178), entitled
2 "An act imposing a tax on the sale or possession of
3 cigarettes and providing penalties," changing provisions
4 relating to payment of certain revenues.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1202, act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513,
8 No.178), known as the "Pennsylvania Cigarette Tax Act," is
9 repealed.

10 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section to read:

11 ~~Section 1202.1. Disposition of Certain Funds. All tax~~ <—
12 ~~revenues collected by the Department of Revenue under this act~~
13 ~~and heretofore paid into the Pennsylvania Nonpublic Elementary~~
14 ~~and Secondary Education Fund shall hereinafter be paid into the~~

16 SECTION 1202.1. DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN FUNDS.--ALL CIGARETTE <—
17 TAX REVENUES COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE UNDER THIS
18 ACT AND HERETOFORE PAID INTO THE PARENT REIMBURSEMENT FUND IN

1 ACCORDANCE WITH THE ACT OF AUGUST 27, 1971 (P.L.358, NO.92),
2 KNOWN AS THE "PARENT REIMBURSEMENT ACT FOR NONPUBLIC EDUCATION,"
3 SHALL BE TRANSFERRED INTO THE GENERAL FUND, AND ALL SUCH
4 REVENUES HEREINAFTER COLLECTED SHALL BE PAID INTO THE GENERAL
5 FUND.
