AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and 3 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," further providing for the contents of certain certificates of title, the sale of certain vehicles, 7 and prescribing penalties. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Section 1. Section 203, act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, 11 No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," is amended by adding a 12 subsection and the Penalty clause is amended to read: 13 Section 203. Contents, Delivery, Effect and Life of Certificate of Title .--14 15 (e) The certificate of title issued for a house trailer, 16 mobilehome, and recreational type trailer shall contain the date 17 18 of the manufacture thereof.

Penalty. -- Any person failing to deliver upon demand a

satisfied certificate of title, as required by the provisions of

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- 1 subsection (b) of this section, shall, upon summary conviction
- 2 before a magistrate, for a first offense, be sentenced to pay a
- 3 fine of ten dollars (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in
- 4 default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for
- 5 not more than five (5) days, and for every subsequent failure to
- 6 deliver upon demand such satisfied certificate of title, be
- 7 sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and
- 8 costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment thereof,
- 9 shall undergo imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days.
- 10 Any person failing to return to the department a certificate
- 11 of title where there are subsequent liens or encumbrances, for
- 12 correction and delivery, as required by the provisions of
- 13 subsection (b) of this section, shall, upon summary conviction
- 14 before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of ten dollars
- 15 (\$10.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of the
- 16 payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than
- 17 five (5) days, and for every subsequent failure to return such
- 18 certificate of title shall be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-
- 19 five dollars (\$25.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default
- 20 of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more
- 21 than ten (10) days: Provided, That no person shall be deemed
- 22 guilty of a violation of this section if he shall deliver the
- 23 certificate of title to the department within forty-eight (48)
- 24 hours of the satisfaction of any lien or encumbrance.
- 25 Any person delivering to another a certificate of title for a
- 26 house-trailer, mobilehome, or recreational type of trailer that
- 27 does not contain the date of the manufacture thereof shall, upon
- 28 <u>summary conviction</u>, be sentenced to pay a fine of three hundred
- 29 dollars (\$300.00) and to undergo imprisonment for not more than
- 30 ninety (90) days.

- 1 Section 2. The act is amended by adding a section and
- 2 Penalty clause to read:
- 3 Section 1309. Sale of Certain Vehicles. -- Every house
- trailer, mobilehome, or recreational type trailer sold in this 4
- 5 Commonwealth shall have placed thereon the date of its
- manufacture. 6
- 7 Penalty. -- A person who violates the provisions of this
- section shall, upon summary conviction be sentenced to pay a 8
- fine of three hundred dollars (\$300.00) and to undergo
- 10 imprisonment for not more than ninety (90) days.
