AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An

act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and 3 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors, " requiring a different operator's license number on duplicate operator's license cards and 7 renewing a penalty. 8 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 10 Subsection (a) of section 613, act of April 29, 11 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," amended 12 September 21, 1959 (P.L.924, No.372), is amended to read: 13 Section 613. Duplicate License Cards .-- (a) In the event that an operator's license or learner's permit shall be lost or 14 15 destroyed, or become illegible, the person to whom the same was issued shall make application to the department, upon a form 16 17 furnished by the department, accompanied by the fee provided in 18 this act, for a duplicate thereof. The duplicate card shall bear 19 a number different from any previously assigned to the operator.

- 1 Penalty.--Any person violating any of the provisions of
- 2 subsection (a) or of subsection (c) of this section, shall, upon
- 3 summary conviction before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a
- 4 fine of five dollars (\$5.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in
- 5 default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for
- 6 not more than three (3) days.
