AN ACT

Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of vehicles and tractors," requiring a different operator's license number on duplicate operator's license cards and renewing a penalty.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 613, act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," amended September 21, 1959 (P.L.924, No.372), is amended to read:

Section 613. Duplicate License Cards.--(a) In the event that an operator's license or learner's permit shall be lost or destroyed, or become illegible, the person to whom the same was issued shall make application to the department, upon a form furnished by the department, accompanied by the fee provided in this act, for a duplicate thereof. The duplicate card shall bear a number different from any previously assigned to the operator. * * *

Penalty.--Any person violating any of the provisions of subsection (a) or of subsection (c) of this section, shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate, be sentenced to pay a fine of five dollars (\$5.00) and costs of prosecution, and, in default of the payment thereof, shall undergo imprisonment for not more than three (3) days.
