## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of May 1, 1913 (P.L.155, No.104), entitled "An
- 2 act regulating the letting of certain contracts for the
- 3 erection, construction, and alteration of public buildings,"
- 4 increasing the minimum bid requirement.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Section 1, act of May 1, 1913 (P.L.155, No.104),
- 8 entitled "An act regulating the letting of certain contracts for
- 9 the erection, construction, and alteration of public buildings,"
- 10 amended September 1, 1967 (P.L.296, No.124), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That hereafter in the
- 12 preparation of specifications for the erection, construction,
- 13 and alteration of any public building, when the entire cost of
- 14 such work shall exceed [one thousand five hundred] two thousand
- 15 dollars, it shall be the duty of the architect, engineer, or
- 16 other person preparing such specifications, to prepare separate
- 17 specifications for the plumbing, heating, ventilating, and
- 18 electrical work; and it shall be the duty of the person or
- 19 persons authorized to enter into contracts for the erection,

- 1 construction, or alteration of such public buildings to receive
- 2 separate bids upon each of the said branches of work, and to
- 3 award the contract for the same to the lowest responsible bidder
- 4 for each of said branches.
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
