10	Section 1. Subsection (d) of section 828, act of April 29,
11	1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code," amended July
12	1, 1968 (P.L.332, No.162), is amended to read:
13	Section 828. Prevention of Noise

15	[(d) No violation charged under this section for causing
16	excessive noise shall be proved except by the testimony of at
17	least two (2) peace officers who were on the scene of the
18	alleged violation each testifying that in his opinion the noise
19	caused was excessive and each describing such excessive noise.]
20	PenaltyAny person violating any of the provisions of this
21	section, shall, upon summary conviction before a magistrate, be

1 sentenced to pay a fine not to exceed twenty-five dollars 2 (\$25.00), and costs of prosecution, or to undergo imprisonment 3 not to exceed fifteen (15) days, or both. Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
