## AN ACT

Amending the act of June 30, 1975 (No.8-A), entitled, "An act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and

3 Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1975 to 5 June 30, 1976, and for the payment of bills incurred and 6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending 7 June 30, 1975, providing an additional appropriation to the 8 Pennsylvania State Police. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 10 hereby enacts as follows: 11 Section 1. Section 2, act of June 30, 1975 (No.8-A), known 12 as the "General Appropriation Act of 1975," is amended by 13 providing an additional appropriation to the Pennsylvania State 14 Police. 15 Section 2. The following sums, or as much thereof as may be 16 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the General 17 Fund to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive, 18 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the payment of the salaries, wages or other compensation and travel 19 expense of the duly elected or appointed officers and employees 20

of the Commonwealth, for payment of fees of contractual services

- 3 other expenses, as provided by law or by this act, necessary for

- 7 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
