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AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled  
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the  
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the  
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative  
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,  
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or  
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or  
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative  
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and  
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative  
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,  
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the  
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive  
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of  
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and  
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,  
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the  
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other  
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and  
20 commissions shall be determined," authorizing the  
21 Pennsylvania State Police to enter into agreements with  
22 boroughs and townships to furnish them with police protection  
23 and authorizing additional personnel for such purposes.

24 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania  
25 hereby enacts as follows:

26 Section 1. Section 205, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,  
27 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended  
28 by adding a subsection to read:

1       Section 205.   Pennsylvania State Police.--\* \* \*

2       (b.1)   The Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police is  
3 hereby authorized to enter into agreements with boroughs and  
4 first and second class townships for the furnishing of police  
5 protection on a contract basis to such municipalities. The  
6 contract price for such services shall be the actual cost for  
7 providing such police protection and moneys so received shall be  
8 credited to the General Fund and used for the express purpose of  
9 financing the services for which the contract price was paid. In  
10 no instance shall this service be financed other than by the  
11 agreed contract price. In addition to the personnel authorized  
12 by subsection (b), additional troopers are hereby authorized to  
13 meet the additional personnel requirements resulting from any  
14 agreements executed pursuant to this subsection. The  
15 Commissioner of the Pennsylvania State Police shall promulgate  
16 whatever rules and regulations are necessary for the  
17 implementation and facilitation of the contractual agreements  
18 authorized by this section.
