## AN ACT

Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, adding provisions defining included 3 offenses. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4 hereby enacts as follows: 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707, No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, 7 amended December 6, 1972 (P.L.1482, No.334), is amended by 8 9 adding a section to read: § 912. Included offenses. 10 11 A defendant may be convicted of an offense included in an offense charged in the indictment or the information. An offense 12 13 is so included when: (1) it is established by proof of the same or less than 14 all the facts required to establish the commission of the 15 16 offense charged; or 17 (2) it consists of an attempt or solicitation to commit the offense charged or to commit an offense otherwise 18

included therein; or

- 1 (3) it differs from the offense charged only in the
- 2 <u>respect that a less serious inquiry or risk of injury to the</u>
- 3 same person, property at public interest or a lesser kind of
- 4 <u>culpability suffices to establish its commission.</u>
- 5 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
