- 1 Amending the act of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), entitled "An
- 2 act consolidating and revising the Vehicle Code, the Tractor
- 3 Code, the Motor Vehicle Financial Responsibility Act and
- 4 other acts relating to the ownership, possession and use of
- 5 vehicles and tractors, "further providing for certain fees.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Clause (1) of subsection (b) of section 729, act
- 9 of April 29, 1959 (P.L.58, No.32), known as "The Vehicle Code,"
- 10 amended December 16, 1975 (No.149), is amended to read:
- 11 Section 729. Exemptions from Fees.--
- 12 * * *
- 13 (b) No registration fee shall be charged for vehicles owned
- 14 by any of the following but the department shall charge a fee of
- 15 ten dollars (\$10.00) to cover the costs of processing for
- 16 issuing or renewing the registration:
- 17 (1) Any person who is retired and receiving social security
- 18 or other pension and whose total income does not exceed seven
- 19 thousand five hundred dollars (\$7,500.00) per year. For the

- 1 purpose of determining income under this clause, moneys received
- 2 <u>from veterans pensions and other veterans benefits shall not be</u>
- 3 <u>included</u>. Said person shall be the principal operator of the
- 4 vehicle but may from time to time authorize another person to
- 5 operate the vehicle in his or her stead. Only one (1) vehicle,
- 6 weighing not more than nine thousand (9,000) pounds, may be
- 7 registered to any person under this paragraph.

- 9 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately and apply
- 10 to registration years commencing April 1, 1977 and thereafter.
