AN ACT

1 Amending the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177, No.175), entitled
2 "An act providing for and reorganizing the conduct of the
3 executive and administrative work of the Commonwealth by the
4 Executive Department thereof and the administrative
5 departments, boards, commissions, and officers thereof,
6 including the boards of trustees of State Normal Schools, or
7 Teachers Colleges; abolishing, creating, reorganizing or
8 authorizing the reorganization of certain administrative
9 departments, boards, and commissions; defining the powers and
10 duties of the Governor and other executive and administrative
11 officers, and of the several administrative departments,
12 boards, commissions, and officers; fixing the salaries of the
13 Governor, Lieutenant Governor, and certain other executive
14 and administrative officers; providing for the appointment of
15 certain administrative officers, and of all deputies and
16 other assistants and employes in certain departments, boards,
17 and commissions; and prescribing the manner in which the
18 number and compensation of the deputies and all other
19 assistants and employes of certain departments, boards and
20 commissions shall be determined," providing for certain
21 information to appear in all publications.

22 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
23 hereby enacts as follows:

24 Section 1. Section 521, act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.177,
25 No.175), known as "The Administrative Code of 1929," is amended
26 to read:

27 Section 521. Publications.--No department, board, or

1 commission shall publish or distribute any publication, map, or
2 document to the public, except through the Department of
3 [Property and Supplies] General Services, unless the Department
4 of [Property and Supplies] General Services shall have consented
5 to the direct publication or distribution of such publication,
6 map or document, by such other department, or by such board or
7 commission.

8 Every publication of a department, board, or commission
9 subject to the provisions of this act shall list in such
10 publication the name of the printing firm, the name of any
11 advertising or public relations firm used in conjunction with
12 the publication, the total cost of the publication and the unit
13 cost of each publication.

14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days and apply
15 to all publications printed after the effective date.
