## AN ACT

- 1 Relating to the capacity of a married person to sue and be sued.
- 2 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 3 hereby enacts as follows:
- 4 Section 1. A married person may sue and be sued civilly, in
- 5 all respects and in any form of action, and with the same effect
- 6 and results and consequences as an unmarried person.
- 7 Section 2. Sections 3 and 4, act of June 8, 1893 (P.L.344,
- 8 No.284), entitled "An act relating to husband and wife,
- 9 enlarging her capacity to acquire and dispose of property, to
- 10 sue and be sued, and to make a last will, and enabling them to
- 11 sue and to testify against each other in certain cases," are
- 12 repealed.
- 13 Section 3. The provisions of this act shall not affect any
- 14 act done, liability incurred, or right accrued or vested, or
- 15 affect any suit or action pending or to be instituted under any
- 16 act or part thereof repealed by this act.
- 17 Section 4. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
