## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of February 1, 1966 (1965 P.L.1656, No.581),
- 2 entitled "An act concerning boroughs, and revising, amending
- and consolidating the law relating to boroughs, authorizing
- 4 appropriations for borough citizen's band radio base
- 5 stations.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 1202, act of February 1, 1966 (1965)
- 9 P.L.1656, No.581), known as "The Borough Code," is amended by
- 10 adding a clause to read:
- 11 Section 1202. Specific Powers.--The powers of the borough
- 12 shall be vested in the corporate authorities. Among the specific
- 13 powers of the borough shall be the following, and in the
- 14 exercise of any of such powers involving the enactment of any
- 15 ordinance or the making of any regulation, restriction or
- 16 prohibition, the borough may provide for the enforcement thereof
- 17 and may prescribe penalties for the violation thereof or for the
- 18 failure to conform thereto:

- 1 (73.2) Appropriation for Citizen's Band Radio Base Station.
- 2 To appropriate funds for the establishment of a borough
- 3 <u>citizen's band radio base station for public service, nonprofit</u>
- 4 use. Not more than one thousand dollars (\$1,000) shall be
- 5 appropriated annually for radio equipment and not more than
- 6 <u>twelve hundred dollars (\$1,200)</u> shall be appropriated annually
- 7 for rental of facilities to house the equipment in the event no
- 8 space is available in existing public buildings.

- 10 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
