9	Section 1. Section 1511, act of March 30, 1949 (P.L.30,
10	No.14), known as the "Public School Code of 1949," amended July
11	31, 1968 (P.L.1020, No.301), is amended to read:
12	Section 1511. Subjects of Instruction; Flag CodeIn every
13	elementary public and private school, established and maintained
14	in this Commonwealth, the following subjects shall be taught, in
15	the English language and from English texts: English, including
16	spelling, reading and writing, arithmetic, geography, the
17	history of the United States and of Pennsylvania, civics,
18	including loyalty to the State and National Government, safety
19	education, and the humane treatment of birds and animals,
20	health, including physical education, and physiology, music

1 [and], art and, at the high school level the theory, history, foundation and operation of the free enterprise system and the 2 3 manner in which the free enterprise system is actually 4 practiced. Other subjects shall be taught in the public elementary schools and also in the public high schools as may be 5 prescribed by the standards of the State Board of Education. All 6 such subjects, except foreign languages, shall be taught in the 7 8 English language and from English texts: Provided, however, That, at the discretion of the [Superintendent of Public 9 10 Instruction] Secretary of Education, the teaching of subjects in 11 a language other than English may be permitted as part of a 12 sequence in foreign language study or as part of a bilingual 13 education program if the teaching personnel are properly certified in the subject fields. Each school district shall 14 15 provide and distribute to each pupil, enrolled in the eighth 16 grade of the public schools, one illustrated copy of the 17 National Flag Code, and shall, from time to time, make available 18 such copies as are necessary for replacements from year to year. 19 It shall be the duty of each teacher in the public schools to 20 make such use of the code as may, from time to time, seem 21 proper.

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22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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
