REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, JANUARY 28, 1975

In the House of Representatives, January 28, 1975 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania directs the Joint State Government Commission to organize a task force to conduct an in depth study of the system of property taxation in Pennsylvania with the goal of revising such taxation if necessary; and be it further

7 RESOLVED, That in organizing the task force mandated by this 8 resolution, the Joint State Government Commission shall include 9 seven members of the House of Representatives, four from the 10 Majority Party and three from the Minority Party, and seven 11 members of the Senate, four from the Majority Party and three 12 from the Minority Party; and be it further

13 RESOLVED, That the Joint State Government Commission report 14 the findings of the task force, along with its recommendations 15 for appropriate legislation, to the General Assembly as soon as 16 possible.
