1 Increases in the cost of electricity have been astronomical
2 in recent months. Utilities producing electrical power allege
3 that increases in the expense involved in the production of
4 power, particularly the cost of coal, is the cause; therefore be

7 direct the Mines and Energy Management Committee to investigate
8 the matter to determine whether the allegation of the electrical
9 utilities is correct and, if so, what legislative action, or
10 otherwise, it recommends to alleviate the condition.
