## HOUSE RESOLUTION No. 123 Session of 1975

## INTRODUCED BY MEBUS, ZEARFOSS, CRAWFORD AND RENNINGER, JULY 1, 1975

REFERRED TO COMMITTEE ON RULES, JULY 2, 1975

In the House of Representatives, July 1, 1975 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, particularly in observance of the Bicentennial of the Nation's founding but also as its constant impetus, affirms its belief in the ideas contained in the Liberty Pledge and therefore pledges in accordance therewith as follows:

б On July 4, 1776, the Founders of our Republic breathed a 7 spirit into American Government totally dependent upon Revealed Truth. This Divine Spirit affirmed the sovereignty of the 8 9 citizen as the just and reasonable consequence of the 10 sovereignty of the soul. To this proposition, the essence of the Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United 11 12 States of America, we pledge our support and, with a firm 13 reliance on the protection of Divine Providence, we mutually pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes and our sacred 14 15 honor.
