In the House of Representatives, July 1, 1975

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives, particularly in
2 observance of the Bicentennial of the Nation's founding but also
3 as its constant impetus, affirms its belief in the ideas
4 contained in the Liberty Pledge and therefore pledges in
5 accordance therewith as follows:

6 On July 4, 1776, the Founders of our Republic breathed a
7 spirit into American Government totally dependent upon Revealed
8 Truth. This Divine Spirit affirmed the sovereignty of the
9 citizen as the just and reasonable consequence of the
10 sovereignty of the soul. To this proposition, the essence of the
11 Declaration of Independence and the Constitution of the United
12 States of America, we pledge our support and, with a firm
13 reliance on the protection of Divine Providence, we mutually
14 pledge to each other our lives, our fortunes and our sacred
15 honor.
