In the House of Representatives, September 20, 1976

1 WHEREAS, The fortitude and spirit of leadership displayed by
2 Christopher Columbus led to the discovery of our country; and

3 WHEREAS, The early pioneer was possessed with confidence and
4 steadfast faith which serves as a constant inspiration to all
5 Americans in this Bicentennial Year as we seek to achieve
6 greater accomplishments in the future; therefore be it

7 RESOLVED (the Senate concurring), That the General Assembly
8 of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby designate that
9 portion of Interstate Highway Route No. 80 commencing in Mercer
10 County and continuing through Monroe County as the "Christopher
11 Columbus Highway."
