A SUPPLEMENT

1 To the act of (P.L. , No.), entitled "An
2 act to provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative
3 and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, the public debt
4 and for the public schools for the fiscal period July 1, 1975
5 to June 30, 1976, and for the payment of bills incurred and
6 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending
7 June 30, 1975," itemizing appropriations required from the
8 Motor License Fund for the proper operation of the several
9 departments of the Commonwealth authorized to spend Motor
10 License Fund moneys.

11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
12 hereby enacts as follows:

13 Section 1. This supplement shall be known and may be cited
14 as the "Motor License Fund Supplement to the General
15 Appropriation Act of 1975."

16 Section 2. The following sums or as much thereof as may be
17 necessary, are hereby specifically appropriated from the Motor
18 License Fund to the hereinafter named agencies of the
19 Commonwealth for the payment of salaries, wages and other
20 compensation and travel expenses of the duly elected or
21 appointed officers and employees of the Commonwealth, for
22 contractual services and other expenses necessary for the proper

1 conduct of the duties, functions and activities for the purposes
2 hereinafter set forth for the fiscal period beginning July 1,
3 1975 and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid
4 at the close of the fiscal period ending June 30, 1975.

5 To the Department of Transportation

6 For the salaries, wages and all necessary ex-
7 penses for the proper administration of the
8 Department of Transportation, including planning and
9 research, engineering, right-of-way, highway con-
10 struction, special projects and services, highway
11 maintenance, service functions and transportation
12 safety..... \$330,781,000

13 For payment from the restricted revenue ac-
14 counts for aviation fuel taxes and airport op-
15 erations revenue, for aviation operations includ-
16 ing the operation and maintenance of State-owned
17 aircraft, payment of general expenses, supplies,
18 printing and equipment; for the development and
19 maintenance of State airports and the maintenance
20 and repair of landing fields, intermediate landing
21 fields, landing field equipment, beacon sites,
22 other navigation facilities, and the encouragement
23 and development of civil aeronautics..... 3,852,000

24 For rental payments to the State Highway and
25 Bridge Authority for projects constructed with
26 funds borrowed by the Authority..... 35,000,000

27 For payments to municipalities to assist in
28 maintenance and construction costs of roads in
29 accordance with the act of June 1, 1956 (P.L.
30 1944, No.655), relative to the allocation of

1	highway funds.....	94,400,000
2	For payment from the restricted revenue ac-	
3	count for aviation fuel taxes for airport con-	
4	struction and development including encouragement	
5	and development of aeronautics, development of	
6	State airports, assistance to political subdivisions	
7	and municipal authorities in the construction and	
8	improvement of airports and other aeronautical	
9	facilities.....	1,550,000
10	No more shall be expended from this item for	
11	such purpose or any of them than may be required	
12	to match an equal sum contributed by any political	
13	subdivision, or municipality authority of the	
14	Commonwealth or by the Federal Government, or by	
15	a political subdivision or municipality authority	
16	and the Federal Government as provided in the act	
17	of May 2, 1947 (P.L.136, No.56), relating to	
18	Federal aid for airports.	
19	To the Treasury Department	
20	For the payment of replacement checks issued in	
21	lieu of outstanding checks when presented and to	
22	adjust errors.....	50,000
23	For payment of the compensation of the Common-	
24	wealth's Loan and Transfer Agent for services and	
25	expenses in connection with the registration,	
26	transfer and payment of interest on bonds of the	
27	Commonwealth and other services required to be	
28	performed by the Loan and Transfer Agent.....	75,000
29	For the payment of approved claims for the re-	
30	funding of moneys collected through the Department	

1	of Transportation to which the Commonwealth is not	
2	entitled.....	650,000
3	For payment of refunds of liquid fuels taxes	
4	for agricultural use to which the Commonwealth	
5	is not entitled.....	5,000,000
6	For the payment of approved claims for the re-	
7	funding of liquid fuels taxes and fuel use taxes	
8	to which the Commonwealth is not entitled.....	5,000,000
9	For the payment of salaries, wages and all nec-	
10	essary expenses in the proper administration of	
11	the program to refund liquid fuels taxes for agri-	
12	cultural use to which the Commonwealth is not	
13	entitled.....	157,000
14	For the payment of approved claims for the	
15	refunding of emergency liquid fuels tax moneys to which	
16	the Commonwealth is not entitled.....	1,000
17	Refunding liquid fuels tax - political sub-	
18	division use.....	1,000,000
19	For the payment of salaries, wages and all nec-	
20	essary expenses for the proper administration of	
21	the refunding of liquid fuels tax - political sub-	
22	division use.....	80,000
23	Refunding liquid fuels tax - to Boating Fund	
24	for the use of the Fish Commission for the im-	
25	provement of the waters of Pennsylvania on which	
26	motorboats are permitted to operate.....	1,200,000
27	For payment of principal and interest require-	
28	ments on general obligation bonds issued for	
29	transportation projects.....	100,854,000
30	For payment of principal and interest require-	

1	ments on general obligation bonds issued for The	
2	General State Authority projects.....	161,000
3	To the Department of Education	
4	For the promotion of the highway safety educa-	
5	tion programs through the schools of the Common-	
6	wealth.....	34,000
7	For assistance to school districts in the es-	
8	tablishment and operation of driver education pro-	
9	grams, and to analyze and improve driver education	
10	courses of study for secondary school pupils and	
11	adults.....	106,000
12	For payments to school districts or joint school	
13	organizations for driver education programs.....	4,218,000
14	To the Department of Property and Supplies	
15	For the payment of rental charges to The Gen-	
16	eral State Authority.....	1,543,000
17	To the Department of Revenue	
18	For the proper administration and enforcement	
19	of the regulations under "The Liquid Fuels Tax	
20	Act," "Fuels Use Tax Act," "Motor Carriers Act,"	
21	and "Bus Compact".....	2,700,000
22	To the Pennsylvania State Police	
23	For transfer to the General Fund to finance the	
24	traffic control and the traffic safety facilities

7 Section 3. In addition to the amounts appropriated by this
8 act, all moneys received from the Federal Government or from any
9 other source as contributions to or payments for the programs
10 provided herein shall be paid into the Motor License Fund and
11 are hereby appropriated out of the Motor License Fund for the
12 purposes and programs intended.

13 Section 4. This act shall take effect July 1, 1975.
