AN ACT

Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal, 2 3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates, primary and election expenses and election contests; creating 5 and defining membership of county boards of elections; imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth, 7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners; imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying, 8 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and 9 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to 10 elections," further providing for the appointment of 11 12 watchers. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. Subsection (a) of section 417, act of June 3, 16 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code, " is amended to read: 17 18 Section 417. Appointment of Watchers. --Each candidate for nomination or election at any primary 19 20 shall be entitled to appoint two watchers, who shall be 21 registered in the same political party as the candidate, in each 22 election district in which such candidate is voted for. Each

political party and each political body which has nominated

- 1 candidates in accordance with the provisions of this act, shall
- 2 be entitled to appoint three watchers at any general, municipal
- 3 or special election in each election district in which the
- 4 candidates of such party or political body are to be voted for.
- 5 <u>In the case of political parties, the watchers shall be</u>
- 6 registered in the political party so appointing, and in the case
- 7 of political bodies, the watchers shall sign an affidavit, to be
- 8 filed with the board of elections, to act only for the candidate
- 9 of the political body so appointing. Such watchers shall serve
- 10 without expense to the county.
