Amending the act of August 5, 1932 (Sp.Sess., P.L.45, No.45), 1 2 entitled, as amended, "An act empowering cities of the first 3 class to levy, assess and collect, or to provide for the 4 levying, assessment and collection of, certain additional 5 taxes for general revenue purposes; authorizing the б establishment of bureaus, and the appointment and 7 compensation of officers and employes to assess and collect such taxes; and permitting penalties to be imposed and 8 enforced, " further providing for the rate of taxation on 9 certain individuals. 10 11 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 12 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. - 2 impose a tax on wages on nonresidents of the city who render
- 3 services in such city in excess of 3 1/3%.
