AN ACT

1 Amending the act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513, No.178), entitled
2 "An act imposing a tax on the sale or possession of
3 cigarettes and providing penalties," deleting certain
4 provisions relating to the disposition of funds.

5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
6 hereby enacts as follows:

7 Section 1. Section 1202.1, act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513,
8 No.178), added June 28, 1975 (No.18), known as the "Pennsylvania
9 Cigarette Tax Act," is amended to read:

10 Section 1202.1. Disposition of Certain Funds.--All cigarette
11 tax revenues collected by the Department of Revenue under this
12 act and heretofore paid into the Parent Reimbursement Fund in
13 accordance with the act of August 27, 1971 (P.L.358, No.92),
14 known as the "Parent Reimbursement Act for Nonpublic Education,"
15 shall be transferred into the General Fund, and all such
16 revenues hereinafter collected [until June 30, 1976] shall be
17 paid into the General Fund. [Cigarette tax revenues collected on
18 and after July 1, 1976 by the department shall be paid into the
19 Parent Reimbursement Fund in accordance with the act of August
20 27, 1971 (P.L.358, No.92).]

21 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
