A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, providing for four-year terms for Members of
- 3 the House of Representatives.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby resolves as follows:
- 6 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 7 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 8 Article XI thereof:
- 9 That section 3, Article II of the Constitution of the
- 10 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania be amended to read:
- 11 § 3. Terms of members.
- 12 Senators and Representatives shall be elected for the term of
- 13 four years [and Representatives for the term of two years].
- 14 Section 2. At the first general election after the effective
- 15 date of this amendment, Representatives in odd-numbered
- 16 districts shall be elected for terms of four years, and
- 17 Representatives in even-numbered districts shall be elected for
- 18 terms of two years.
