AN ACT

1 Amending the act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), entitled
2 "An act concerning elections, including general, municipal,
3 special and primary elections, the nomination of candidates,
4 primary and election expenses and election contests; creating
5 and defining membership of county boards of elections;
6 imposing duties upon the Secretary of the Commonwealth,
7 courts, county boards of elections, county commissioners;
8 imposing penalties for violation of the act, and codifying,
9 revising and consolidating the laws relating thereto; and
10 repealing certain acts and parts of acts relating to
11 elections," providing for certain compatible offices.

12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
13 hereby enacts as follows:

14 Section 1. The act of June 3, 1937 (P.L.1333, No.320), known
15 as the "Pennsylvania Election Code," is amended by adding a
16 section to read:

17 Section 809.2. Compatible Offices.--Any county employe may
18 be an officer of any political body or political party and he
19 may hold the office of a county, State or national committee of
20 any political party, and may participate in any election day
21 activities.

22 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
