AN ACT

Creating the Veterans Memorial Commission as a temporary body to develop detailed plans for the creation of a State memorial 3 honoring Pennsylvania servicemen and to submit a report of its findings, recommendations and proposed legislation to the 4 5 General Assembly. 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 8 Section 1. There is hereby created a temporary commission to be known as the Veterans Memorial Commission for the purpose of 10 developing plans for the creation of a State memorial at the 11 Indiantown Gap National Cemetary in honor of Pennsylvania 12 servicemen. 13 Section 2. The memorial commission shall consist of six members as follows: 14 15 (1)The Adjutant General. 16 (2) The Secretary of General Services.

The Executive Director of the Pennsylvania

Historical and Museum Commission, who shall be the chairman

- 2 (4) A member of a veterans organization appointed by the

- 3 State War Veterans Council. ADJUTANT GENERAL.
- 4 (5) A member of the House of Representatives to be
- 5 appointed by the Speaker thereof.
- 6 (6) A member of the Senate to be appointed by the
- 7 President pro tempore thereof.
- 8 The members of the commission shall serve without
- 9 remuneration.
- 10 Section 3. The memorial commission shall have the power and
- 11 duty to develop detailed plans including site, size, costs and
- 12 other similar relevant items and facts germane to the creation
- 13 of a State Memorial. It shall present its findings and
- 14 recommendations together with drafts of necessary legislation to
- 15 effectuate the same in a written report to the General Assembly.
- 16 Upon submission of such report or the expiration of two years
- 17 from the effective date of this act, whichever is earlier, the
- 18 commission shall expire.
- 19 Section 4. This act shall take effect immediately.
