AN ACT

Amending the act of December 11, 1967 (P.L.707, No.331), entitled "An act providing for and regulating thoroughbred 3 horse racing with pari-mutuel wagering on the results thereof, creating the State Horse Racing Commission as an 5 independent administrative commission and defining its powers 6 and duties; providing for the establishment and operation of 7 thoroughbred horse racing plants; imposing taxes on revenues of such plants; disposing of all moneys received by the 8 9 commission and all moneys collected from the taxes; authorizing penalties; and making appropriations," 10 authorizing racing at licensee's discretion during certain 11 12 hours on Sunday. 13 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 14 15 Section 1. Subsection (c) of section 7, act of December 11, 1967 (P.L.707, No.331), referred to as the State Horse Racing 16 Law, amended September 26, 1973 (P.L.271, No.75), is amended to 17 18 read: 19 Section 7. Licenses for Thoroughbred Horse Racing Meetings.--* * * 20 21 (c) Applications for licenses shall be in such form as may be prescribed by the commission and shall contain such 22 information or other material or evidence as the commission may 23

- 1 require. The term "racing week" shall include Sunday at the
- 2 discretion of the licensee but no racing shall be authorized or
- 3 permitted on that day [except between the hours of one and seven
- 4 o'clock] before one o'clock post meridian.

- 6 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
