AN ACT

- 1 Requiring advice of the need of a cytology (Papanicolaou) test
- 2 for uterine cancer detection of any woman receiving hospital
- 3 care, for the purpose of detecting uterine cancer early and
- 4 reducing the morbidity and mortality therefrom.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby enacts as follows:
- 7 Section 1. Any female of childbearing age or older who is
- 8 accepted for any reason, either as an inpatient or outpatient,
- 9 in any hospital or clinic defined as such by the Commonwealth
- 10 shall be advised of the purpose of and the availability of tests
- 11 for the detection of uterine cancer, of an appropriate cytology
- 12 test of the Papanicolaou type, to be examined and reported upon
- 13 by an appropriate, qualified cytologist in a laboratory approved
- 14 by the Department of Health.
- 15 Section 2. The Pennsylvania Department of Health is hereby
- 16 authorized to prepare directives to hospitals and clinics to
- 17 include in the patient medical records a section indicating
- 18 whether advisement of the intent and availability of tests is
- 19 applicable, the date when such advice and information was

- 1 offered and the name or initials of the person offering such
- 2 advice and information. The attending physician shall be
- 3 responsible for insuring that this form is completed.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
