L4	SEVEN AND ONE-HALF HORSEPOWER RATING MAY BE OPERATED ON QUAKER	
L5	LAKE IN SUSQUEHANNA COUNTY IF THE MOTOR IS RENDERED INOPERABLE	
L6	BY REMOVAL OF THE PROPELLER, AND SUCH PROPELLER IS LEFT ASHORE.	
L7	AFTER REMOVAL OF THE PROPELLER, A MOTOR OF NOT MORE THAN SEVEN	

AND ONE-HALF RATING MAY BE ATTACHED TO THE BOAT AND USED FOR

- 1 PROPELLING THE BOAT ON QUAKER LAKE.
- 2 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
