## A SUPPLEMENT

To the act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), entitled "An

2 act providing a permanent allocation of a part of the fuels 3 and liquids fuels tax proceeds to cities, boroughs, incorporated towns and townships, for their road, street and 4 5 bridge purposes; conferring powers and imposing duties on 6 local officers and the Department of Highways; and making an 7 appropriation out of the Motor License Fund; and repealing existing legislation, " waiving certain provisions relating to 8 allocations for road construction UNDER CERTAIN CONDITIONS. 9 10 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 11 12 Section 1. For the fiscal period commencing April 1, 1976 and ending March 31, 1978 the provisions of clause (2) of 13 section 4, act of June 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, No.655), entitled 14 15 "An act providing a permanent allocation of a part of the fuels 16 and liquids fuels tax proceeds to cities, boroughs, incorporated 17 towns and townships, for their road, street and bridge purposes; conferring powers and imposing duties on local officers and the 18 Department of Highways; and making an appropriation out of the 19 20 Motor License Fund; and repealing existing legislation, are

- 1 hereby waived.
- 2 Section 2. Whenever the Governor declares a state of
- 3 emergency clause (2) of section 4, of said act is waived for the

- 4 entire fiscal year in which said state of emergency is declared.
- 5 SECTION 2. WHENEVER THE GOVERNOR PROCLAIMS A STATE OF
- EXTREME EMERGENCY PURSUANT TO THE ACT OF JULY 6, 1961 (P.L.515,
- NO.265), THE PROVISIONS OF CLAUSE (2) OF SECTION 4 OF THE ACT OF
- JUNE 1, 1956 (1955 P.L.1944, NO.655) ARE WAIVED FOR THE AREA
- 9 PROCLAIMED TO BE IN A CONDITION OF EXTREME EMERGENCY FOR THE
- 10 ENTIRE FISCAL YEAR IN WHICH THE PROCLAMATION IS MADE.
- Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately. 11
