| hereby enacts as follows:  |
| Section 1. Clause (c) of section 1601, act of June 3, 1937   |
| (P.L.1333, No.320), known as the "Pennsylvania Election Code,"   |
| is amended to read:  |
| Section 1601. DefinitionsAs used in this article, the  |
| following words shall have the following meanings:   |

| (c) The words "political committee" shall include every two  |
| or more persons who shall be elected, appointed or chosen, or  |
| who shall have associated themselves or cooperated for the   |

purpose, wholly or in part, of raising, collecting or disbursing money, or of controlling or directing the raising, collection or disbursement of money for primary or election expenses. <u>In</u> <u>addition to the above, political committee shall include any two</u> <u>or more persons who advocate the passage or defeat of any matter</u> <u>which appears as a ballot question.</u>

7 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
