## AN ACT

Amending the act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), entitled "An act regulating and improving the civil service of certain 3 departments and agencies of the Commonwealth; vesting in the 4 State Civil Service Commission and a Personnel Director certain powers and duties; providing for classification of positions, adoption of compensation schedules and 6 7 certification of payrolls; imposing duties upon certain 8 officers and employes of the Commonwealth; authorizing service to other State departments or agencies and political 9 subdivisions of the Commonwealth in matters relating to civil 10 service; defining certain crimes and misdemeanors; imposing 11 penalties; making certain appropriations, and repealing 12 13 certain acts and parts thereof, "further providing for the holding of examinations. 14 15 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows: 16 17 Section 1. The act of August 5, 1941 (P.L.752, No.286), 18 known as the "Civil Service Act," is amended by adding a section 19 to read: 20 Section 503.1. Periods of Testing. -- (a) The director shall 21 suspend for a period of one year the holding of examinations 22 when the eligibility list for a particular position contains the 23 names of four times the number of anticipated vacancies within

- 1 said time period, of available candidates, by designated
- 2 regions.
- 3 (b) If the director believes that a need for testing exists
- 4 for positions in a particular region of the Commonwealth he may
- 5 <u>authorize limited testing to be given only in FOR said region to <---</u>
- 6 those persons willing to accept employment in said region.
- 7 Section 2. Section 505 of the act amended August 27, 1963
- 8 (P.L.1257, No.520), is amended to read:
- 9 Section 505. Ratings of Competitors.--The final earned
- 10 rating of a person competing in any examination shall be
- 11 attained by computing the ratings for each part or parts of the
- 12 examination, the qualifying point for which is set by the
- 13 director under the direction of the commission according to
- 14 weights for each test established by the director. The director
- 15 shall send notice by mail to all competitors informing them
- 16 [whether they have attained a place upon the list and informing
- 17 those who have attained a place upon the list of the number who
- 18 took the examination, the number on the list, and of their
- 19 relative standing upon the list.] as to their score and whether
- 20 they passed or failed. Whenever an examination is closed those
- 21 competitors in that region, as determined pursuant to section
- 22 503.1, will be notified of the number who took the examination,
- 23 the number on the list and of their relative ranking in that
- 24 region.
- 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect immediately.
