## AN ACT

- 1 Amending the act of December 6, 1972 (P.L.1464, No.333),
- 2 entitled "An act relating to the care, guidance, control,
- 3 trial, placement and commitment of delinquent and deprived
- 4 children, " further providing for the disposition of
- 5 delinguent children.
- 6 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 7 hereby enacts as follows:
- 8 Section 1. Section 25, act of December 6, 1972 (P.L.1464,
- 9 No.333), known as the "Juvenile Act" is amended to read:
- 10 Section 25. Disposition of Delinquent Child. -- (a) If the
- 11 child is found to be a delinquent child the court may make any
- 12 of the following orders of disposition best suited to his
- 13 treatment, supervision, rehabilitation, and welfare:
- 14 (1) Any order authorized by section 24 for the disposition
- 15 of a deprived child.
- 16 (2) Placing the child on probation under supervision of the
- 17 probation officer of the court or the court of another state as
- 18 provided in section 34, under conditions and limitations the
- 19 court prescribes.
- 20 (3) Committing the child to an institution, youth

- 1 development center, camp, or other facility for delinquent
- 2 children operated under the direction or supervision of the
- 3 court or other public authority and approved by the Department
- 4 of Public Welfare.
- 5 (4) Committing the child to an institution operated by the
- 6 Department of Public Welfare or special facility for children
- 7 operated by the Department of Justice.
- 8 (b) No child shall be committed to any State institution
- 9 operated by the Department of Public Welfare if the child has
- 10 been adjudicated for an act, if applied to an adult, would
- 11 constitute the crime of rape, robbery, involuntary deviate
- 12 <u>sexual intercourse</u>, arson where bodily injury has resulted,
- 13 <u>kidnapping</u>, <u>murder</u>, <u>assault or voluntary manslaughter</u>.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 30 days.
