AN ACT

Amending the act of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), entitled "An

2 act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive, 3 Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977; to make additional appropriations from the Federal augmentation to 5 the Executive Department for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 7 to June 30, 1977, and to appropriate the Federal funds available for implementation of Title II, Public Law 94-369, 8 9 to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive Department, " changing and adding appropriations and making 10 11 editorial changes. 12 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 13 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. - 7 beginning July 1, 1976 and for the payment of bills incurred and
- 8 remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal period ending June
