## AN ACT

- Amending the act of November 26, 1976 (No.55-A), entitled "An act to further provide for the expenses of the Executive, Legislative and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth for 3 the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977; to make 5 additional appropriations from the Federal augmentation to 6 the Executive Department for the fiscal period July 1, 1976 to June 30, 1977, and to appropriate the Federal funds 7 8 available for implementation of Title II, Public Law 94-369, to the several hereinafter named agencies of the Executive 9 Department, " changing and adding appropriations and making 10 11 editorial changes.
