## AN ACT

Amending the act of July 22, 1970 (P.L.513, No.178), entitled 1 2 "An act imposing a tax on the sale or possession of cigarettes and providing penalties, " changing the cigarette 3 stamping agencies permitted to pay for purchases on a 4 5 deferred basis. The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 6 7 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Subsection (e) of section 301, act of July 22, 8 1970 (P.L.513, No.178), known as the "Pennsylvania Cigarette Tax Act," is amended to read: 10 Stamp to Evidence the Tax. -- \* \* \* 11 Section 301. 12 The department shall by regulation permit [only] a [Pennsylvania domiciled] cigarette stamping agency to pay for 13 14 purchases on a deferred basis, upon the filing of a surety bond, 15 of the type approved by the department, with the department, in an amount deemed sufficient by the department to protect the 16 17 revenue, said bond to be executed by the cigarette stamping agency as principal and by a corporate surety company, duly 18 19 authorized to engage in such business in the Commonwealth of

1 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
