AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, adding and grading the crime of theft
- 3 by conversion.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- 7 No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes, is
- 8 amended by adding a section to read:
- 9 § 3932. Theft by conversion.
- 10 (a) Offense defined.--A person is quilty of theft by
- 11 conversion who purchases a thing on an installment payment
- 12 system or sales contract and converts it by selling or giving it
- 13 to another and thereafter refuses to satisfy the unpaid balance
- 14 of the debt.
- 15 (b) Grading.--
- 16 (1) A person committing the offense of theft by
- 17 conversion is quilty of a misdemeanor of the third degree if
- 18 the unpaid balance of the debt is less than \$300.

- (2) A person committing the offense of theft by 1
- 2 conversion is quilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree if
- 3 the unpaid balance or debt is \$300 or more.
- Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days. 4
