10	Section 1. Section 1, act of August 12, 1971 (P.L.313,

16	Section 1. Notwithstanding any provision of any policy of
17	insurance, self-insured sickness, health and/or welfare plan
18	providing benefits issued or renewed after the effective date of
19	this act, whenever such policy <u>or plan</u> provides for
20	reimbursement for any service which may be legally performed by

a person licensed under the laws of the Commonwealth for the
practice of medicine, osteopathy, dentistry, chiropractic or
podiatry, reimbursement under such policy <u>or plan</u> shall not be
denied when such service is rendered by a person so licensed.
Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
