AN ACT

1 Regulating the cutting and removing of timber and prescribing
2 penalties.

3 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
4 hereby enacts as follows:

5 Section 1. Permit to cut or remove timber required.

6 Any person who desires to cut or remove timber on the lands
7 of another shall apply to the Department of Environmental
8 Resources for a permit to cut timber. The application for the
9 permit shall clearly specify the location where the timber is to
10 be cut and shall also include written permission of the owner of
11 the land and a description of type and amount of timber to be
12 cut. The fee for the permit shall be \$100.

13 Section 2. Penalty.

14 Any person cutting or removing timber in violation of this
15 act shall be guilty of a summary offense and shall, upon
16 conviction, be sentenced to imprisonment for up to 90 days or to
17 pay a fine of up to \$1,000 or both.

1 Section 3. Effective date.

2 This act shall take effect in 90 days.
