- Amending Title 18 (Crimes and Offenses) of the Pennsylvania
- 2 Consolidated Statutes, providing for the right of arrest
- 3 without a warrant for certain offenses.
- The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 4
- hereby enacts as follows: 5
- 6 Section 1. Title 18, act of November 25, 1970 (P.L.707,
- No.230), known as the Pennsylvania Consolidated Statutes is
- amended by adding a section to read: 8
- § 113. Arrest without warrant.
- 10 (a) General rule. -- A law enforcement officer shall have the
- same right of arrest without a warrant for a graded offense as 11
- 12 exists or may hereafter exist in the case of the commission of a
- 13 felony.
- 14 (b) Conviction of misdemeanor or summary offense. -- An arrest
- without a warrant for a graded offense shall not be invalidated 15
- solely by reason of the fact that defendant was convicted of a 16
- 17 misdemeanor or summary offense.
- (c) Definitions. -- As used in this section the following 18

- 1 words and phrases shall have the meanings given to them in this
- 2 subsection:
- 3 <u>"Graded offense." An offense defined by this title or by any</u>
- 4 other statute which:
- 5 (1) is graded into two or more classes of offenses as
- 6 provided in section 106 (relating to classes of offenses);
- 7 and
- 8 (2) includes either a felony of the first, second or
- 9 <u>third degree as one of the grades into which the offense is</u>
- 10 <u>classified in addition to any lower grades.</u>
- 11 <u>"Law enforcement officer." Any police officer or other</u>
- 12 person who by virtue of his office or public employment is
- 13 <u>vested</u> by law with the power or duty to make arrests for
- 14 offenses, whether that power or duty extends to all offenses or
- 15 <u>is limited to specific offenses.</u>
- 16 Section 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
