A JOINT RESOLUTION

- 1 Proposing an amendment to the Constitution of the Commonwealth
- of Pennsylvania, requiring that provisions for sufficient
- 3 revenues be enacted prior to consideration of the general
- 4 appropriation bill for any fiscal year.
- 5 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 6 hereby resolves as follows:
- 7 Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of
- 8 the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania is proposed in accordance with
- 9 the provisions of Article XI thereof:
- 10 That Section 11, Article III be amended to read:
- 11 § 11. Appropriation bills.
- 12 No general appropriation bill for any fiscal year shall be
- 13 considered by either house of the General Assembly until the
- 14 bills for raising revenue for that year shall have been enacted.
- 15 The general appropriation bill shall embrace nothing but
- 16 appropriations for the executive, legislative and judicial
- 17 departments of the Commonwealth, for the public debt and for
- 18 public schools. All other appropriations shall be made by
- 19 separate bills, each embracing but one subject.
